



Anne Frank Play Available for Schools

"In Holland Stands a House" is a play by former teacher Sue Saunders and is the story of Anne Frank who with her family went into hiding during the Nazi occupation in Holland. The play interweaves a dramatised account of events in Europe with domestic scenes from the secret annex. The script draws strongly on Anne's diary. The "Play plus" series provides scripts for reading aloud in the English classroom as well as for improvisation and performance work. Each play is followed by resource material: poems, extracts, photographs, original documents. These explore topics related to the script and provide starting points for improvisation, discussion and creative writing.

The play is very simply staged, has an expandable cast of 15 - 60 (depending upon the size of the chorus which makes the background explicit) and has full lesson notes and suggestions for activities. It is published by Collins Educational.
