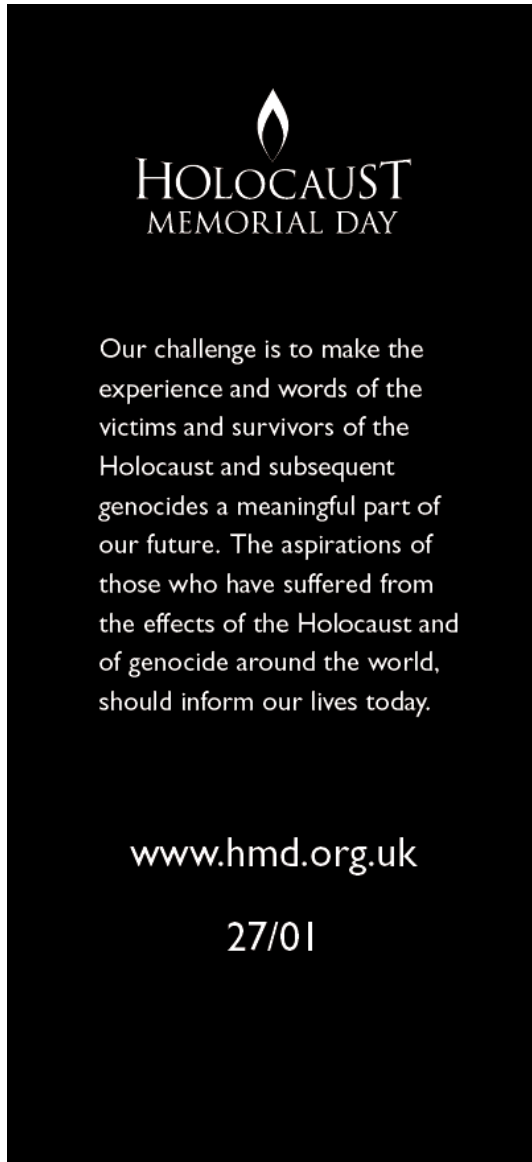




## My Family

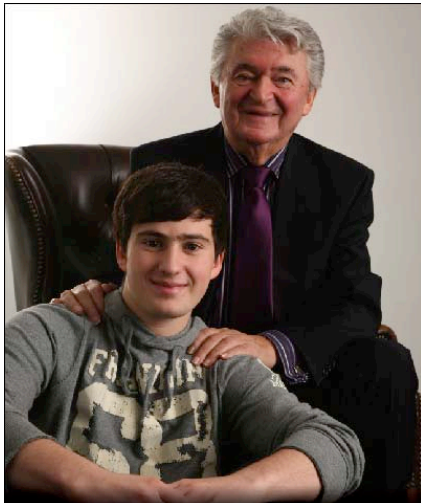
